Awards

PCOM will award one \$500 scholarship to an undergraduate college student. The winning essay may be published either online or in print. The winner will be announced at a spring groundbreaking ceremony.

Timeframe

Essays, up to 500 words, are due to the Southwest Georgia Area Health Education Center (SOWEGA-AHEC) office by Monday, March 19. Please email entries to lcalhoun@sowega-ahec.org. Essays must be in a Word-compatible document and double-spaced with the entrant's contact information including name, address, school, year, email address and phone number clearly indicated. One college student will be notified of his/her winning entry by April 9.

Eligibility

The college student must be an undergraduate student who considers his/her hometown to be in one of the following counties: Atkinson, Bacon, Baker, Ben Hill, Berrien, Brooks, Calhoun, Clay, Clinch, Coffee, Colquitt, Cook, Crisp, Decatur, Dooly, Dougherty, Early, Echols, Grady, Irwin, Lanier, Lee, Lowndes, Miller, Mitchell, Pulaski, Quitman, Randolph, Seminole, Stewart, Sumter, Terrell, Thomas, Tift, Turner, Webster, Wilcox and Worth.

Judging

The SOWEGA-AHEC, together with PCOM officials, will determine the winning essay. Essays will be judged for adherence to the topic, organization, interest and originality.
