Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine (PCOM) Opportunities Academy is an enrichment program that aims to introduce students who identify as African-American, Black, Hispanic, or Latinx, or are traditionally underrepresented in medicine to opportunities in healthcare, college readiness, and mentoring.

Students attending the PCOM opportunities Academy will:

- + Engage in career exploration in medicine and healthcare
- + Practice critical thinking skills and collaboration by engaging in problem-based learning
- + Build research, public speaking, and presentation skills through innovative experiences in the program
- + Develop the skills and self-confidence to apply and successfully navigate college
- + Engage in leadership and professional development at every stage

Sample Curriculum and Experiences:

- + Lessons in nutrition, heart anatomy lab, brain anatomy lab, trauma simulation, CPR
- + Introduction to healthcare careers including but not limited to, physician, counseling, research, physician assistant
- + Job shadowing opportunities with research staff
